- ✓ Prevent water from getting polluted.

Dont's

- ✓ Don't litter the mountains while travelling.
- ✓ Don't leave any eatables along the road side for wild animals.
- ✓ Don't let the caterer of your travel agent leave any eatables behind for wild animals. Make sure that utensils are not washed in the stream but through collection water in a bucket or a jerry can. Water gradient is not to wash off the left over food.
- ✓ Don't spit in water stream while brushing.
- ✓ Don't wash your clothes in water springs or streams. Never discharge saponified water in water sources.
- ✓ Don't defecate or urinate near river banks and spring beds.
- ✓ Don't leave your undergarments behind after bath as the colours and nylon, synthetic fiber in cloth is a pollutant.

Guidelines for Mountaineering Expeditions in Uttarakhand

Introduction:-

The State of Uttarakhand also known as devbhumi, or the land of God's, wears a mantle of mountain ranges, which endow it with a breathtaking natural beauty and sheer range of diversity. 83 peaks in Uttarakhand are open to mountaineers. These high mountain areas cover a substantial geographical area of the State, forming important catchments of major river system in India, and are a repository of rich Himalayan biodiversity. It is a major challenge to ensure a balance between allowing mountaineering activities in such an area with the need to preserve fragile Himalayan environment for posterity. Mountaineering is emerging as one of the popular adventure sports in Uttarakhand and needs to be promoted in a regulated manner with adequate environment safeguards, so that the world will have sustained tourism interest in high mountain areas of Uttarakhand within permissible limits. This guideline have been developed towards that objective.

Awareness and Promotion:-

The Uttarakhand Tourism Development Board (UTDB) will be the nodal agency to promote mountaineering and allied activities in the various mountaineering destinations of Uttarakhand. It will coordinate and liaise with the concerned departments and agencies within and outside the state for this purpose. The Garhwal Mandal Vikas Nigam (GMVN) and Kumaon Mandal Vikas Nigam (KMVN) will provide all possible logistical supports for such promotional activities.

Procedure of Application:-

Proposal from Foreign Nationals

Any proposal by foreign nationals to undertake mountaineering expeditions in Uttarakhand, must be submitted to the Indian Mountaineering Foundation (IMF) at Delhi. The IMF will coordinate with the concerned ministries in the Government of India and the Chief Wildlife Warden (CWLW), Uttarakhand, to get the necessary clearances.

The application to the IMF must be made on the prescribed form along with the requisite supporting documents. Thereafter, the IMF will refer the proposal simultaneously to the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Ministry of Defence, Government of India, as well as the Uttarakhand Government, for clearance.

Foreigners entering Uttarakhand are required to be in possession of Inner Line Permits for areas where required, besides valid passports and visas.

Uttarakhand Government does not permit scaling of peaks that are located within the Nanda Devi National Park, or which required access through the National Park.

Proposal from Indian Nationals

Indian nationals must also submit their applications to the IMF. The processing of the applications by the State Government, as well as the terms and conditions for the expedition, wherever applicable, will be the same as for foreign nationals, except for the fee and security deposit structure.

Referring Proposal to the State Government

IMF shall refer an application to the State Government on behalf of the expedition team at least four weeks before the proposed commencement of the expedition. Proposals sent directly to the State Government will not be entertained. For a centralized single window clearance, the State Government has appointed the following officer, and all references to the State Government in this regard should be addressed to:

Clearance by the State Government

The process of clearance by the State Government is as follows:

The proposal sent to the CWLW, Uttarakhand, by IMF on behalf of the expedition party, must contain information in **Form No. 1** as prescribed by the State Government. After checking the above-said application form filled by the expedition team, the IMF will forward the form, complete in all respects, to the State Government on behalf of the mountaineering party at least four weeks before the proposed expedition date. Incomplete applications are liable to summary rejection.

After due examination of the proposal by the CWLW, intimation of its approval or otherwise shall be sent to the IMF within a week from the date of receipt of the complete application at the office of the CWLW. On approval, a copy of the proposal along with the route maps and other details will be sent to the concerned District Magistrate, Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) and Superintendent of Police for information about the ensuing expedition in the area. All the above-mentioned officers will immediately issue the necessary directions to the concerned field staff in this regard.

IMF will issue a letter of final clearance in favour of the expedition party on the basis of approval granted by the State Government and concerned ministries. The IMF shall also address a copy of this letter to the concerned DFO, as proof of clearance by all concerned ministries. It should be handed over to the forest staff manning the Expedition Check Post (ECP), by the Liaison Officer (LO) in the case of a foreign expedition, and the Team Leader (TL) in the case of an Indian expedition. IMF shall direct the LO and TL to contact the Sub District Magistrate (SDO) for an Inner Line Permit, and the DFO of the concerned Forest/Wildlife Division, to convey the date and time of arrival at the ECP at least 48 hours in advance. The concerned SDO and DFO shall automatically issue the Inner Line Permit and other Department has identified ECPs enroute various open mountain peaks in **Annex I**.

Measures for Environmental Safety

The forest Department (FD) will be the nodal agency to monitor and regulate mountaineering as per the existing laws of forest conservation, environment protection and wildlife protection, as well as the allied ruled applicable in the area.

Measures for Ensuring Garbage Disposal

Before the commencement of the expedition, the LO or TL of the team, as the case may be, must compulsorily declare the biodegradable as well as non-biodegradable waste material being carried by the team. At the ECP. The TL shall pledge a security deposit in the form of a demand draft amounting to Rs 10,000/- for a foreign expedition and Rs. 5,000/- for an Indian expedition, in favour of the concerned DFO, and hand it over to the local Forest Range Officer at the ECP.

(See Form No. 1 (Part IV) for detailed instructions)

On return, the team must give an undertaking in **Form No. 2** to the effect that it has carried back all the non-biodegradable waste material generated by it at various camps, and suitably disposed the biodegradable waste. The team must declare all the non-biodegradable waste generated during the expedition and deposit the same at the ECP or at a suitable site on a road head as designated by the DFO. The security deposit will be released at the earliest by the local Range Officer after she/he certifies the deposit of non-biodegradable garbage at the ECP.

It shall be the responsibility of the FD to transport the non-biodegradable garbage from ECP/designated site, to the recycling zone.

IMF shall remit the Environmental Levy (**Annex III**) collected from each mountaineering party, to the Uttarakhand Government for activities to ensure the long-term environmental safety of the region.

Measures for Ensuring Carriage of Sufficient Food and Fuel

The TL shall ensure the provision of sufficient food and fuel for the core expedition team members and porters for the onward and return journey from successive transit camps and the base camps. The TL must give an undertaking to this effect at the ECP. (**See Form No.1 (Part IV)** for detailed instructions)

Number of Core Expedition Team Members and Frequency of Expeditions

Each expedition will comprise a maximum of 10 core expedition members including a doctor, but excluding the LO. Not more than two additional climbing members will be allowed on payment of a prescribed, additional Peak Fee in case of mixed expeditions. A maximum of 4 high altitude porters/guides/sherpas shall be allowed per climbing members till the base camp. However, only 2 porters/guides/Sherpa will be allowed per climbing member from the base camp to the peak.

The maximum number of expeditions to a particular peak by any route will be limited to 2 expeditions per calendar month. However, not more than twelve expeditions shall be allowed in on calendar year to any particular peak and satellite peaked in close proximity. IMF will ensure that the applications conform to the prescribed number of core expedition members, porters/guides/sherpas and frequency of expeditions. The expedition team must strictly adhere to the information provided by the IMF to the CWLW with respect to the expedition.

Monitoring the Environmental and Socio-economic Impact

Every two years, the environmental and socio-economic impacts will be monitored through ground levels surveys in the three mountaineering hubs of Uttarkashi, Chamoli and Pithoragarh Districts to determine the carrying capacity of mountaineering/high mountain trekking activities in Uttarakhand. The surveys will be conducted by independent national and international expert agencies such as the Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology, Wildlife Institute of India, GB Pant Institute of Himalayan Environment and Development and International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development (ICIMOD), among others. A portion of the Peak Fee and Environmental Levy remitted by IMF to the State Government will be utilized for this purpose. International funding and technical assistance will be solicited for the study of carrying capacity of higher Himalayan areas.

Local communities shall be integrally involved in various mountaineering activities through appropriate policies. This may include activities such as providing commodities for mountaineering activities like rations, fuel, equipment and other services at transit and base camps. Training to build the capacities of local communities to add value to service promoting ecotourism-based mountaineering activities will be provided. A portion of the Expedition Fee remitted to the Uttarakhand Government will be utilized to impart such training. The Forest Department will coordinate and liaise with different resource/expert agencies to provide such training.

Local tour operators, guides, helpers and porters will be registered with the office of the DFO as per conditions laid down by the State Government. For details, see **Annex-II**.

It shall be the duty of the IMF to fully brief the expedition team members on the environment norms of the State and take necessary steps to ensure their compliance. The LO/TL will be required to submit **Form No. 2** duly filled and as prescribed, to the Forest Range Officer at the ECP on return.

Fees and Tariff

The IMF will deposit the Expedition Fee accruing to the State Government at the CWLW's office by way of demand draft made out to the Director, Rajaji National Park, payable at Dehradun, along with the application form. The Expedition Fee will include the Peak Fee, Camping Site Fee and Trail Management Fee, as well as the Service Charge of Uttarakhand Government and the Environmental Levy. In case of the expedition route passing through National Parks and Sanctuaries, the entry fee for such protected areas shall be deposited in addition to the fees enumerated above. Permission for filming will be granted as per existing norms on individual basis. For a detailed list of the fees and tariff payable to the State Government, please see **Annex III**.

Utilization of Expedition Fee

A portion of the Expedition Fee will be used for activities, including the following::

- Recycling non-biodegradable waste
- Office transactions
- Promotional activities
- Development and maintenance of camping sites and trails
- Monitoring of environmental and socio-economic impacts
- Capacity building of stakeholder departments
- Capacity building of local communities

- General safety measures
- Benefit sharing with the community

The State Government will develop a procedure for allocation of funds for the above listed purposes. It will seek necessary assistance from the IMF and mountaineering training institutions within the State for search and rescue operations in the State.

Terms and Conditions to be observed for All Expeditions in Uttarakhand in General

The terms & conditions are as follows:

- ❖ Of all the High Altitude Porters (HAP), helpers and guides being used by the expeditions, at least 50% will comprise local persons.
- ❖ All expeditions shall ensure return of non-biodegradable waste generated by them to the ECP. They shall undertake to abide by such terms and conditions as may be further stipulated in this regards by the State Government.
- ❖ Expedition teams shall abide by the relevant laws of the State, during their stay in Uttarakhand.
- ❖ It shall be mandatory for all teams to travel only along the permitted route. Permission for deviation from the permitted route shall be given by the CWLW only under exceptional circumstances. The team leader must bring any such deviation to the notice of local DFO at the first opportunity.
- ❖ The team shall not carry any weapons and/or injurious substances, which can injure, harm or kill any wildlife or destroy their habitat. The team shall not poach Kindly fires or leave burning embers, destroy, deface or remove any wildlife, trees herbs, shrubs, sign-posts etc. during the expedition.
- ❖ The team shall ensure carriage of a sufficient quantity of kerosene oil and LPG for heating and cooking purposes. The use of firewood is strictly prohibited during the expedition.
- ❖ The team shall refrain from polluting waters with human and kitchen waste.
- ❖ The team shall carry sufficient quantity of bags/containers for bringing all non biodegradable waste back from transit camps and base camp to be deposited on return at the ECP.
- ❖ The team is advised to avail of all infrastructure facilities (boarding, lodging and transport) available with the State Government such as Tourist Rest House, Forest Rest House and Home-stay facilities available in the villages enroute.
- ❖ The State Government shall not be responsible for any loss of life or property of any expedition team.

Liaison Officer

The IMF will nominated a liaison officer, preferably from Uttarakhand, to coordinate and liaise for expeditions within Uttarakhand.

Note 1:

List of open peaks of Uttarakhand-with their location in terms of coordinated, prescribed routes, Forest/Wildlife Divisions, National Parks and Sanctuaries, ECPs and forest and tourist rest houses enroute, and the concerned DFOs to whom the prescribed security deposit for garbage disposal is to be pledged by the expedition teams – is attached as **Annex I**.

Note 2:

Mountaineering expeditions booked through registered travel agencies, mountaineering clubs and training institutions headquartered in Uttarakhand and operating in Uttarakhand for the last three calendar years, shall be eligible for a 5% rebate on the peak Fee payable to the State Government. The IMF will grant such a rebate and remit the payable Peak Fee to the State after deducting the prescribed rebate amount at their end. These agencies will assist the state Government in environmental campaigns, mountaineering-training and in search-and-rescue operations, as requested from time to time, failing which the rebate may be withdrawn.

Guidelines for Regulation of Local Tour Operators Providing Services to Mountaineering Expeditions

Local tour operators providing unorganized labour or any other services to mountaineering expeditions will be registered with the DFO on fulfilling the following conditions:-

1. The local tour operator must be domiciled in the district of operation.
2. Character verification is a must.
3. The local tour operator will pledge a security deposit of Rs. 1000/- to the concerned local DFO during registration annually. A minimal annual registration fee of 100/- per operator will be payable.
4. It will be the responsibility of the local tour operator to register the porters/guides /helpers at the DFO's office and renew the registration annually, by February-end.
5. Only registered porters/guides/helpers shall be allowed to accompany mountaineering expeditions.
6. The local tour operator will group insure all the porters/guides/helpers.
7. Porters/guides/helpers will not be paid below the rate fixed by the local District Magistrate for any particular year.
8. The local tour operator will ensure proper clothing, insurance, rations and fuel for their porters/guides/helpers.
9. The porters/guides/helpers need not pay any Registration Fee to the FD. It shall be mandatory for the local tour operator to ensure the training-cum-orientation of all porters/guides/helpers. The FD will organise the required orientation/refresher workshops for porters/guides/helpers before the start of the mountaineering season in every calendar year, and from time to time, as and when required, conduct other capacity-building workshops.
10. The cost of organising these training workshops will be borne from the Expedition Fee remitted to the State Government. The minutes of these workshops will be recorded in the DFO's office and will be circulated to all the district level officers of stakeholders departments.
11. Every local tour operator should have an office with a clearly designated address.
12. Local tour operators will be liable for the violation of any rules, acts and laws, by the porters/guides/helpers.

Fees and Tariff for Mountaineering Expeditions in Uttarakhand (Expedition Fees)

The Expedition Fee includes:

1. Peak Fee payable to Uttarakhand Government for climbing a particular peak.
2. Enroute Camping Site Fee and Trail Management Fee.
3. Service/Handling charge of the State Government.
4. Environmental Levy.
5. National Parks and Sanctuaries Fee, where applicable.
6. Professional Filming Fee in National Parks and Sanctuaries, where applicable.

Norms for depositing Expedition Fees for Mountaineering in Uttarakhand:

1. For convenience and for a single window clearance, the instructions on page 9 of the guidelines should be followed for depositing fees and tariff.
2. An additional amount of 20% per head will be levied on the peak Fee payable to the State Government by the IMF for the inclusion of every additional expedition member up to a maximum of 2 members beyond the 10 members team, in case of mixed expeditions.
3. All mixed expeditions will be considered foreign expeditions for the calculation of the Expedition Fee by the State Government.
4. In case the expedition route falls through National Parks and Sanctuaries, the team will have to deposit an additional amount of Rs. 2,000/- as Entry Fee in National Parks and Sanctuaries.
5. A security deposit of Rs. 10,000/- for foreign expeditions and Rs. 5000/- for Indian expeditions for bringing back the non-biodegradable waste generated at various camps is refundable on the termination of the expedition, if the local Range Officer at the ECP certifies the return of non-biodegradable garbage.
6. Government Institutions like Nehru Institute of Mountaineering (NIM) imparting training on mountaineering in Uttarakhand will be totally exempted from peak fee, environment levy and handling charge of the State Government. However, camping site fee and entry fee into Parks and Sanctuaries which will be charged per training programme per batch as applicable to one Indian Expedition Team. No exemption will be provided in case of sponsored mountaineering expeditions conducted by these institutions. The concerned institutions need to intimate the local DFO for such exemption giving the details of number of trainees, trainers and duration of stay at least 15 days in advance along with the draft of the prescribed fee. The local DFO will be responsible for keeping the record of exemption granted on such grounds. These training institutions will ensure to keep the mountain environment clean and assist the State Government in environmental campaigns, mountaineering training, conducting scientific studies, giving technical advice on mountain related adventure issues, setting up search and rescue team and assisting in search and rescue operations as requested from time to time.
7. Members of an expedition team desirous of commercial filming in National Parks and Sanctuaries need to apply individually along with the prescribed fee to the CWLW at the time when the expedition case is referred to the CWLW for intimation. The prescribed fee is given as follows:
