07:00 AM - 01:00 PM (After tea / breakfast)

Location Name: **Har Ki Pauri**

Have your tea and breakfast in Har ki Pauri

01:00 PM - 02:00 PM (Lunch break enroute)

Location Name: **Har Ki Pauri**

Har Ki Pauri is the most famous ghat on the banks of the Ganges at Haridwar. This is the ghat that witnesses the daily aarti ritual and welcomes crowds which flock the banks for the aarti. The ghat is also known as Brahmakund and mythology suggests that Lord Shiva and Lord Vishnu had visited this place during the vedic times. A temple is built around a large footmark which is believed to be the imprints of Lord Vishnu. Budget and luxury hotels are located near Har ki Pauri to house all types of visitors and guests who visit Haridwar.

Day 03 BARKOT TO YAMUNOTRI TO BARKOT

Barkot is a town and a nagar palika in Uttarkashi district in the state of Uttarakhand, India. It is located on the banks of the Yamuna river.

10:00 AM - 11:00 AM (Holy path & pooja darshan)

Location Name: **Yamunotri Temple**

Yamunotri is one of the Char Dhams and is also the first place to visit in the Char Dham Circuit. Thousands of tourists visit the Yamunotri temple of Goddess Yamuna from April to October. Yamunotri temple was constructed by Maharaja Pratap Shah of Tehri Garhwal. The temple holds great significance amongst the Hindus as the place is the source of the Yamuna river which is one of the major rivers of India. This sacred temple is located at 3,235mts above sea level and it could be reached by an easy trek of 13kms. Barkot is situated 49kms before Yamunotri.

Day 04 BARKOT TO GANGOTRI TO HARSIL

01:00 PM - 02:00 PM (Visit Vishwanath temple)

Location Name: **Gangotri**

One of the main religious places among the four Char Dham pilgrimage areas, Gangotri, situated in Uttarkashi, is closely related to Goddess Ganga, the river that we know as Ganges. The history of Gangotri dates back to centuries when Goddess Ganga transformed herself into a river to dissolve the sins of King Bhagirath's forefathers, following his penance. Gangotri is a popular pilgrim place in India, which stands at an altitude of 3042m and emits a highly pious aura. Religious rituals are in full swing in the Gangotri temple with the aarti ceremony performed by the pujaris of the Semwal family. The river Ganga originates from the Gangotri glacier and is known as Bhagirathi. The name Ganga picks up later on after the river passes Devprayag and merges into the river Alaknanda. The striking presence of the snow-clad mountains in the vicinity and the pure crystal clear water of the Ganges flowing around add to the sanctity of the place. Vegan food dominates the culture and is available in the local food joints or dhabas. Non-vegetarian food and alcoholic drinks are a strict no-no.

Harsil - Unexplored Valley. Harsil is an unspoiled and hidden jewel of Uttarakhand state offering ample scope for people seeking peace and serenity in the lap of Himalayas. It is situated on the banks of Bhagirathi River at an elevation of 2620 mts above sea level.

12:00 PM - 01:00 PM (Visit the Tehri DAM at Gadolia/Bhagirathipuram)

Location Name: **New Tehri**

The district headquarters of Tehri Garhwal is 11 km from Chamba and is a new model town adjoining one of the biggest dams in the hills. Meeting point of the rivers Bhagirathi and Bhilangana is a sight worth seeing.

01:00 PM - 05:30 PM (Lunch at TRH Srinagar/enroute)

Located on the way to N.H. 58 on the bank of river Alaknanda was once the capital of Garhwal Kings. Centre of Garhwal University, it is the biggest township in the area.

Guptakashi, Gupta Kashi or Guptkashi is a fairly large town located at an elevation of 1,319 metres (4,327 ft) in the Kedar-khanda (khanda means sector), in Garhwal Himalayas of Rudraprayag district in Uttarakhand, India. It is known for its ancient Vishwanath Temple dedicated to the God Shiva.

It is the base to the Kedarnath trek. The village has hot water springs and a temple dedicated to Goddess Gauri.

Day 08 KEDARNATH TO GAURIKUND TO RUDRAPRAYAG

Kedarnath is a town in the Indian state of Uttarakhand and has gained importance because of Kedarnath Temple. It is a nagar panchayat in Rudraprayag district.

It is the base for the Kedarnath trek. The village has hot water springs and a temple dedicated to Goddess Gauri.

02:00 PM - 05:00 PM (On the way to Tilwara)

Tilwara is a small town situated on the banks of the Mandakini river.

05:00 PM - 10:00 PM (Dinner & night halt)

Location Name: **Rudraprayag**

Rudraprayag is a town and a municipality in Rudraprayag district in the Indian state of Uttarakhand. Rudraprayag is one of the Panch Prayags of Alaknanda River, the point of confluence of rivers Alaknanda and Mandakini.

Day 09 RUDRAPRAYAG TO JOSHIMATH TO BADRINATH

Location Name: **Rudraprayag**

Visit the Jagadamba temple and Shiva temple here.

12:00 PM - 01:00 PM (Visit Narsing temple, Jyotirmath & lunch break)

Location Name: **Joshimath**

Joshimath is one of the four 'maths' created by Adi Shankaracharya. Joshimath is the home of Shri Badrinath during winters.

Joshimath is connected with Auli by the highest cable car of Asia. Joshimath is situated at an elevation of 1,890mts above sea level. Do visit Kalpavriksha and Narsing temple while on a visit to Joshimath. It is situated 14kms from Joshimath.

Badrinath is located at an elevation of 3,133mts above sea level in the Chamoli district of Uttarakhand state. This Dham was established by Adi Shankaracharya in the 9th century.

Day 10 BADRINATH TO JOSHIMATH TO CHAMOLI

09:00 AM - 11:00 AM (One way traffic/ after holy dip & morning pooja/darshan & tea / breakfast, visit Mana village)

Location Name: **Badrinath Temple**

Badrinath is the most sacred Dham of India. It is located at an elevation of 3,133mts above sea level in the Chamoli district of Uttarakhand state. This Dham was established by Adi Shankaracharya in the 9th century. The deity of Badrinath temple is Lord Vishnu. The temple is situated on the right bank of the holy Alaknanda River.

11:00 AM - 02:00 PM (Lunch at TRH Joshimath)

Location Name: **Joshimath**

Joshimath is one of the four 'maths' created by Adi Shankaracharya. Joshimath is the home of Shri Badrinath during winters. Joshimath is connected with Auli by the highest cable car of Asia. Joshimath is situated at an elevation of 1,890mts above sea level. Do visit Kalpavriksha and Narsing temple while on a visit to Joshimath. It is situated 14kms from Joshimath.

Chamoli, the abode of Gods, reputed for its shrines and temples, birthplace of 'Chipko Movement' with its strategic significance is one of the hill districts of Uttarakhand. Chamoli has proved itself to be the most spectacular in its natural assets; be it maintaining the scenery, valley aspects, water edges, floristic varieties, dramatic landform or the climatic cardinalities.

Situated on the banks of the Alakananda river, Gauchar is a small town in Chamoli district.
